**'Facial Plastic Surgery Update'**

**Facial Plastic Update** will provide an in-depth overview of the evolution of Facial Plastic Surgery, tracing its development from ancient practices to contemporary innovations. The presentation will begin with a historical review of the specialty, followed by a detailed exploration of key procedures, techniques, and their expected outcomes.

Update aims to provide both historical insight and practical understanding of the current standards and future directions in facial plastic surgery.

Dr. Gentile is a globally recognized, board-certified Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeon, known for pioneering innovations like the LaserSmartLift® and UltraLift®. With dual surgical training from Baylor College of Medicine and extensive experience as an author, educator, and innovator, he has contributed significantly to facial rejuvenation techniques. He currently serves as Professor and Dir. of Aesthetic Facial Surgery at the European College of Aesthetic Medicine and Surgery, where he leads international master-classes and has trained 100+ surgeons worldwide.

**'Care of Cancer Patients & How To Manage Them'**

The course emphasizes how dental practitioners should be integrated into the cancer care team: untreated oral disease or trauma can disrupt cancer therapy courses.

The (NIH) recommendation: every patient undergoing chemotherapy or head/neck radiation should receive a pretreatment oral evaluation and have potential sources of infection addressed before initiation.

Oral complications often emerge during therapy, and radiation effects may persist long-term, requiring extended follow-up.

Dr. Susan E. Calderbank, D.M.D., is a distinguished dental educator and clinician with deep ties to both the Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine (LECOM) and the University of Pittsburgh. A graduate of the University of Pittsburgh School of Dental Medicine (Class of 1977) and Chatham College, Dr. Calderbank practiced general dentistry privately for over 40 years before transitioning into academic and leadership roles. At LECOM, she serves as Director of Regional Outreach and Director of Patient Care, and she has also taught in the Department of Oral Medicine at the University of Pittsburgh. A former Chair of the Pennsylvania State Board of Dental Examiners and an ADEX examiner, she is nationally recognized for her advocacy and expertise in oral care for cancer patients—an interest inspired by personal experience caring for her mother. Dr. Calderbank has lectured nationally and internationally on the oral complications of cancer therapies and has received numerous honors, including the Pennsylvania Dental Association's Special Public Service Award and recognition from Thiel College for her professional and civic contributions.

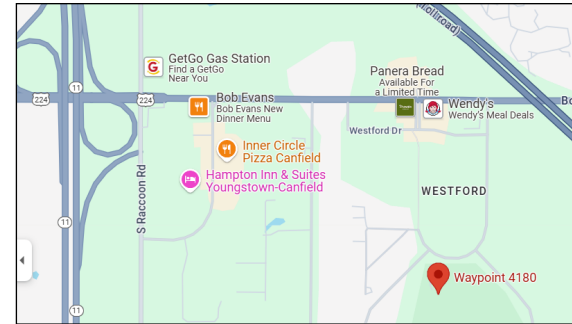
